Dear Lunches For Learning (L4L) contributors,

L4L has just finished a very successful 2005 school year. We fed lunch to 104 elementary school children each school day during 2005. We will double the number of children to 215 during the 2006 school year. The level of success can be demonstrated in articulation rates, attendance records, and academic improvements. The positive impact your lunch program is having on the children and community will be the subject of an upcoming letter, this letter is to discuss some of the more mundane administrative house-keeping chores that must be accomplished so that the children can be fed.

Let me start with the caveat that the L4L staff consists of volunteers, all of whom have full time jobs and families. The primary thrust of staff activities during 2005 has been to develop the logistics necessary to feed the children each school day, uninterrupted. We understand that our focus has left some loose ends in our administrative tasks here at home. Included is a statement of your giving during 2005 through November. If this statement is not consistent with your records, please notify us so that we can adjust to accurately reflect your participation. As we develop the L4L project, our administrative procedures will become more routine and more proficient. We ask for your understanding, your input, and your continued support as we grow this very meaningful endeavor.
