Dear Friends of L4L,

Because of your support, L4L is finishing a very successful and rewarding school year of providing a lunch to 104 elementary school children at El Alatillo, Honduras each school day. Because of your help the drop-out rate at the elementary school has plummeted and the daily attendance rate has dramatically increased. Because of your support the teaching staff has stabilized and parents are making improvements to the school facilities. After repairing certain school facilities, the parents sent word to us that these repairs are a token of their appreciation for the lunch program. We are making a difference and we haven't said a word; all we do is provide lunch for hungry school children.



Because of your generous support, L4L will enlarge the lunch program to include 215 elementary school children in rural Honduras during the upcoming 2006 school year (February 2006 through December 2006). There were three major factors in this decision:

- We were very conservative in our 2005 school year budget estimates (we did not want to project a low cost and run out of money mid-year so we estimated a little high). We can feed more children with the same money.
- Your generous support continues and new friends have joined us.
- The L4L staff decided that, rather than simply monitor the present program, we would challenge ourselves for the '06 year as we did for the '05 year.

We hope that you are enriched, and encouraged by the positive impact you are having through your L4L program.
